


Ask the Lord of the harvest

"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few, therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.' (Matt 9:38) *We pray for missionaries to be sent out from the West, the South, and from Africa.*

"But no one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. Then indeed he may plunder his house.' (Mark 3:27) *Oh Lord, bind the strong man (Satan) and plunder his house (rescue those who are bound by Satan).*

"The god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God." (2 Cor 4:4) *Oh God, lift the veil that covers the eyes of unbelievers and let them see the light of the gospel.*

"Open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus." (Acts 26: 18)

“But thanks be to God, who in Christ, always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of Him everywhere.” (2 Cor 2:14-15) *In your abundant mercy Lord, open the door to the Gospel among this people and lead your people in triumphal procession in Christ, spreading everywhere the fragrance of Christ.*

“Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how He has had mercy on you.” (Mark 5:19) *We pray for new believers to have courage to go tell their friends and family what the Lord has done for them.*

“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions.” (Joel 2:28). *Jesus we pray that you would appear to many in dreams and visions and cause them to seek to know you.*

May each one feel the weight of sin and long to receive freedom. We ask for repentance and a willingness to receive the gospel of grace in Jesus. May they hear and believe.

Lord you know each man, woman, and child. You know each hair on their head and you know where they are. We pray that you would reach them at their point of need and deliver them from darkness and bring them into your glorious light.

“I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.” (Matt 16:18) *Jesus, build your church among this people. Protect your people from the schemes of the enemy.*

“When anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what has been sown in his heart.” (Matt 13:19) *Lord, grant understanding and faith to those who hear your word. Don't let the evil one snatch it away.*
